

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE CONSUMER FINANCIAL PROTECTION BUREAU (CFPB)
AND
THE U.S. CONSUMER PRODUCT SAFETY COMMISSION

I. PURPOSE.

This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA or agreement) sets forth an agreement between the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB) and the U.S Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) regarding Kelly Moore's detail to the CFPB Office of Enforcement.

II. AUTHORITY.

This MOA is entered into pursuant to Section 601 of the Economy Act of 1932, as amended (31 U.S.C. 1535).

III. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE DETAIL.

- a. Duration. The detail will begin on 9/8/2015, and last six (6) months, until 3/8/2016. At the end of the detail, Kelly Moore will return to the U.S Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC).
- b. Title. During the detail, Kelly Moore will have the title of Detailee unless other title is agreed upon.
- c. CFPB Duties. While with the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB), Office of Enforcement, Kelly Moore will assist in Enforcement investigations, developing and implementing investigating strategy, including identifying investigation goals and methodology. Kelly will act as an Attorney assisting with developing and where appropriate, litigating enforcement actions in federal court and administrative proceedings, seeking civil penalties and other remedies.
- d. CFPB Benefits from this Detail Assignment. This detail assignment will provide the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB) with the experience and skills of an Attorney from another government enforcement agency. The Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB) will derive a benefit from having this detailee contribute to our workforce for the duration of the detail. The detail assignment will also allow us at the Bureau to learn about practices, procedures and policy perspectives of another agency.
- e. Facilities and equipment. The Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB) shall provide adequate workspace, computer equipment, office telephone, and other supplies required for the performance of this detail. The U.S Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) will provide any resources or supplies required for the performance of the U.S Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) related duties.
- f. Limited Duties for the U.S Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC). Kelly Moore may use official time to satisfy a few the U.S Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) duties during the course of the detail, including, for example, maintaining the U.S Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) training requirements to include completing courses to fulfill appropriate the U.S Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) training and/or development programs.

- g. Funding. This detail will be funded by the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB). The Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB) will reimburse the U.S Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) each month, through IPAC, for personnel costs and benefits for the period beginning 9/8/2015 through 3/8/2016.
- h. Leave and Work Schedule. Any leave requested by Kelly Moore during the detail will be approved by her Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB) supervisor. The CFPB supervisor will certify that the time and attendance for Kelly Moore is reported accurately and will fax or e-mail a certified time and attendance record and any leave requests the second Friday of each biweekly pay period to Ms. Mary Murphy at (301)504-0359 or to MMurphy@cpsc.gov. Ms. Moore's timekeeper or Ms. Murphy will then enter in the time as certified by CFPB, into the WebTA system. Any travel in connection with this detail will be funded by the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB). During the detail her official duty station will be Washington, DC.
- i. Fiscal Data. The following accounting information shall apply to the funds transferred by the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB) to the U.S Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) during the performance of this detail.

- l. Schedule of Duty. During the detail, Kelly Moore will keep the same basic time and attendance schedule he/she has at the U.S Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC).

IV. IMPLEMENTATION AND AMENDMENT.

- a. This MOA shall become effective upon the signatures of both authorities.
- b. This MOA may be amended or terminated at any time by the mutual agreement of both parties in writing.
