Summary of Meeting

The meeting was chaired by Geoffrey Frohnsdorff, Chief, Building material Division, Building and Fire Research Laboratory, National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST). Mark Eilbert, LSEL and William Rowe, EHHA, attended for CPSC. The meeting had been called by Mr. Frohnsdorff in response to numerous inquiries regarding slip resistance. There are approximately 11 different ASTM standards addressing that issue.
