Summary of Meeting

Mr. Hoppenworth requested a meeting with CPSC staff to discuss a new product - a CO detector tester - that is being developed for the residential market. The meeting was closed because proprietary information about the product was discussed.

The CO detector tester is a device that would test whether the sensor in a CO detector is sensitive to CO. The test button on most CO detectors currently on the market test only whether the circuitry and other components of the detector, such as the horn, are working; it does not indicate whether the sensor in the detector is continuing to be sensitive to CO.

Mr. Hoppenworth indicated that the product still is in development and requested information from the staff as to general safety and labeling requirements for products, as well as information about the Underwriters Laboratories, Inc. standard 2034 for CO detectors/alarms.
