SUMMARY OF TELEPHONE CALL: Mr. Wilson informed Mr. Smith about the mid-year review briefing on April 11 at which the possibility of funding later in fiscal year 1997 was identified by the Executive Director for two purposes: (1) additional in-depth investigations of accidents involving ATV's; and (2) a risk exposure survey. Mr. Smith said that he was aware of the Federal Register notice that had been published identifying the possibility that the Commission would ask the Office of Management and Budget for clearance to conduct such an information gathering program. Mr. Smith said that he hoped that the results of data compilation about ATV accidents would be taken into account in any CPSC decision about extending or modifying the consent decree. Mr. Wilson informed Mr. Smith that the list of invitees to the ATV roundtable to be held at the Commission on May 6 was available.
