SUMMARY OF MEETING:

The purpose of the meeting was to take action on 28 comments received in response to publication of a draft Recommended Practice for the Installation of CO detectors. These comments are available from NFPA in a memorandum to the Technical Committee dated April 17, 1997.

The areas of focus of those 28 comments were: clarification of wording and definitions; detector location issues; whether the document should proceed with the NFPA process or be sent back to Committee; performance capabilities, such as capacity of power supply, length of alarm signal, standby power supply capacity. The NFPA committee reviewed each comment and

took one of the following actions: accept, reject, accept in principle, accept in principle in part. The actions taken at the meeting will be printed in a letter ballot to be sent to the voting members of the Technical Committee, along with minutes for the meeting. It is anticipated that the document reflecting the actions taken and voted upon by the committee will be presented for vote at the general membership meeting in Kansas City in November 1997.
