SUMMARY OF TELEPHONE CALL: Mr. Smith said that the ATV industry planned to comment on the CPSC's proposed ATV exposure survey during the review conducted by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB). The comments would mention the direct dialing survey techniques and some of the questions used in the survey. The ATV industry had retained some experts to help it prepare comments. Mr. Wilson said that the exposure survey was an important part of the record for any eventual Commission decision on ATV's, and that OMB should be encouraged to have its best available people review the proposed exposure survey.
