SUMMARY OF MEETING

This meeting addressed the following:

ISO/NP 11750 Child Resistant (CR) Packaging-Requirements and Testing Procedures for Non-Reclosable Packages.

Resolution 3/1995

The committee agreed to suspend work on ISO/NP 11750 Child resistant packaging-Requirements and testing procedures for non-reclosable packages pending the circulation of the draft prEN 862 by CEN (Committee for European Normalization). When available this standard will be circulated to the committee to determine if it is suitable for adoption by ISO.

ISO 8317:1989-Child-Resistant Packaging-Requirements and Testing Procedures for Reclosable Packages (res. 2/1991).

Resolution 4/1995

The committee requests its Working Group 3 to consider the feasibility of preparing an amendment to ISO 8317 Child resistant packaging-Requirements and testing, to include mechanical testing methods and to examine the new US protocols and other existing protocols.

The National Center for Health Statistics in Washington, D.C. receives mortality reports from all 50 states. The annual data reports show that the number of deaths involving all household products among children under five years of age declined since 1972. The Consumer Product Safety Commission also examines the number of deaths resulting from the accidental ingestion of aspirin-containing products. The first regulation passed under the Poison Prevention Packaging Act required child-resistant packaging for aspirin. At the time the regulation passed, aspirin products were the most frequently ingested product by young children.
