

WINDOW SCREENS KEEP BUGS OUT BUT WON'T KEEP KIDS IN

- Never depend on screens to keep children from falling out of windows.
- Open windows from the top—not the bottom, whenever possible.
- Keep furniture away from windows, to discourage children from climbing near windows.

Use Window Guards or Window Stops to safeguard your children

Install window guards

- to prevent children from falling out of windows.

For windows on the 6th floor and below, install window guards that adults and older children can open easily in case of fire.

Install window stops

- so that windows open no more than 4 inches.
