TRIP REPORT

ISO TC92/SC1 and its Working Groups met November 2-4 in London hosted by the British Standards Institution (BSI).

CPSC's Standard for the Flammability of (Open-Flame) of Mattress Sets (16 CFR Part 1633) was approved as an ISO New Work Item Proposal (NWIP) in October 2008. A Working Draft was developed by members of SC1/Working Group 7. ISO Working Draft (WD) 12949, *Standard Test Method for Measuring the Heat Release Rate of Low Flammability Mattresses and Mattress Sets*, was balloted as a Committee Draft (CD) in July 2009 for three months; comments were discussed at an October 2010 meeting. Draft International Standard (DIS) 12949 was balloted February 26, 2010 for a six month comment period closing July 26, 2010. The comments were discussed during the London meeting.

Members of Working Group 7 discussed and addressed the comments received during the DIS ballot period. Proposed changes were incorporated into the DIS and sent forward for approval by the Subcommittee. It was agreed and approved by the Subcommittee that the revised document should advance to a Final Draft International Standard (FDIS). It was also agreed that a new document would be circulated by end of November for a two-week final review by WG 7 before going out for FDIS ballot in early 2011. FDIS ballot results are expected to be received before the April 2011 meetings.

The next meeting of SC1 and its Working groups will be hosted by AFNOR and held April 4-8 in Paris, France as part of the TC92 Plenary Meeting.
