ITEM:

ANPR to amend and update the Standards for the Flammability of Clothing Textiles

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (3-0) to approve the draft Federal Register notice with specific changes to issue an advance notice of proposed rulemaking (ANPR) discussing possible changes to the Commission's Standards of the Flammability of Clothing Textiles, 16 CFR 1610, under the Flammable Fabrics Act (FFA). The changes include revisions and updating the test equipment and test methods to reflect modern technologies, text reorganization for clarity, and clarification and amendments for new fabrics. The possible changes the Commission discusses in the notice would not affect the sleepwear standards.
