SUMMARY OF MEETING: The meeting started with Ms. Pellengrini providing an introduction on the role that AAP plays in enhancing the well being of infants and toddlers and the launch of a new website called HealthyChildren.org. Dr. Gardnder provided an overview of the issues this his committee focuses on. Topic discussed during the meeting included: the CPSIA and AAP's role in

shaping the legislation, lead paint and lead content, heavy metals, choking hazards, and well baby check up with pediatricians. The Chairman expressed her appreciation for the partnership CPSC has established with the AAP to create a safe sleep video and other educational videos that could be disseminated to pediatricians and shared with new parents. The Chairman and AAP also discussed the means by which all juvenile product recall announcements could be shared with pediatricians.
