Agreement of the Commission to Assume Responsibilities of the Designated Representative of the American Institute in Taiwan under the Memorandum of Understanding

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously 3-0 to agree to act as the Designated Representative of the American Institute in Taiwan (AIT). The Memorandum of Understanding between AIT and the Taipei Economic and Cultural Representative Office in the United States (TECRO) for cooperation associated with Consumer Product Safety Matters provides a framework through which AIT, through a designated representative, the Commission, can provide expertise, information exchange and other support in consumer product safety to TECRO and its designated representative, the Bureau of Standards, Metrology and Inspection, Ministry of Economic Affairs of Taiwan.
