SUMMARY OF MEETING: Representatives of the ZAC Foundation visited to discuss the Commission's vote interpreting "unblockable drains" required by the Virginia Graeme Pool and Spa Safety Act. Ms. Cohn recognized that the Chairman did not vote in favor of the Commission position, and asked what could be done to get the law reinterpreted. Ms. Cohn noted that she also met with Commissioner Adler concerning his vote and the reasoning behind it in an effort to have the decision reversed.
