OKK Trading, Inc., Proposed Civil Penalty Settlement of \$665,000.00
(Briefing package dated June 24, 2009, OS No. 4141)

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (2-0) to provisionally accept the Settlement Agreement and Order, which would order OKK Trading, LLC, to pay a civil penalty of \$665,000.00. The provisional Settlement Agreement and Final Order will be announced in a *Federal Register* Notice. The Commission's Office of General Counsel Compliance Division staff negotiated a proposed agreement of \$665,000.00 to settle the allegations that OKK Trading, LLC, knowingly committed repeated violations of the Consumer Product Safety Act ("CPSA") and the Federal Hazardous Substances Act ("FHSA") by importing, distributing and illegally exporting toys and other children's articles that failed to comply with statutory and regulatory requirements. The violations constituted prohibited acts under the section 19(a)(1) of the CPSA, 15 U.S.C. § 2068(a)(1), or sections 4(a), (c) and (i) of the FHSA, 15 U.S.C. § 1263(a), (c) and (i). Section 20(a)(1) of the CPSA, 15 U.S.C. § 2069(a)(1), permits the imposition of civil penalties for any person who knowingly violates section 19 of the CPSA. Similarly, section 5(c)(1) of the FHSA permits the imposition of civil penalties for a firm's knowing violations of the Prohibited Acts of section 4 of the FHSA.
