Section 103 of the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act, Tracking Labels; Notice of Inquiry
(Briefing package dated February 13, 2009, OS No. 3720)

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (2-0) to approve the draft *Federal Register* as drafted asking for comments on various issues concerning tracking labels. Section 103 of the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act ("CPSIA") requires that effective August 14, 2009, the manufacturer of a children's product must place permanent distinguishing marks on the product and its packaging that provides certain identifying information. In preparation for implementing this requirement, the staff prepared the draft FR notice asking for comments.
