**MINUTES OF COMMISSION MEETING**  
March 17, 2010

Chairman Inez M. Tenenbaum convened the March 17, 2010, 9:00 a.m., meeting of the U. S. Consumer Product Safety Commission in open session. Commissioners Thomas H. Moore, Nancy A. Nord, Robert S. Adler and Anne M. Northup were in attendance. Chairman Tenenbaum made welcoming remarks and introduced the decisional matter.


Notice of Proposed Rulemaking for Toddler Beds under Section 104(b) of the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act of 2008 ("CPSIA")

Chairman Tenenbaum asked the Commission whether there was any discussion about the proposed rulemaking for a safety standard for toddler beds to be published in the *Federal Register* ("FR"). There being none, Chairman Tenenbaum asked for any motions. Commissioner Adler made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Moore, to approve amendments to the proposed rule FR notice. There being no discussions of the amendments, the Commission voted unanimously (5-0) to approve the amendments prepared by Commissioner Adler. Commissioner Adler made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Moore, to approve the proposed rule as amended. There being no discussions of the amendments, the Commission voted unanimously (5-0) to approve, as amended, the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking proposing a standard for Toddler Beds under section 104(b) of the CPSIA for publication in the *FR*.

Notice of Proposed Rulemaking for Bassinets and Cradles under Section 104(b) of the CPSIA

Han Lim, Mechanical Engineer, Directorate for Engineering, Barbara Little, General Attorney, Office of General Counsel, Risana Chowdhury, Mathematical Statistician, Directorate for Epidemiology, and Jill Jenkins, Economist, Directorate for Economics, briefed the Commission on the issuance in the *FR* of a proposed rule for safety standards for bassinets and cradles under section 104(b) of the CPSIA. After their briefing the staff responded to questions from the Commission, indicating in response to several questions that the staffer who could answer was not in town for the briefing. No decisions were made during this part of the meeting.

There being no further business on the agenda, Chairman Tenenbaum adjourned the meeting at 10:00 a.m.
